SOUTH CAROLINA STINGRAYS (5-2) AT ADIRONDACK THUNDER (5-2)

SERIES TIED, 1-1

THE MATCHUP

The South Carolina Stingrays visit the Adirondack Thunder for Game 3 of the 2016 Kelly Cup Playoffs Eastern Conference Semifinals this evening. The series is tied, 1-1. Game 1 in Charleston went to the Thunder, 5-4, but the Stingrays responded with a 1-0 victory in Game 2. The series now shifts to Glens Falls for Games 3-5. Both clubs are coming off 4-1 series victories in the opening round, with South Carolina beating #7 Kalamazoo and the Thunder topping #3 Manchester. The two teams met three times during the regular season with South Carolina posting a 1-1-0-0 record versus the Thunder. The Stingrays are the all-time ECHL leader in playoff victories and are tied for the most Kelly Cup Championships with three.

QUICK HITS

GAME 2 RECAP

Austin Fyten's goal midway through the second period of play proved to be the only goal needed as the Stingrays evened the best-of-seven series with the Adirondack Thunder with a 1-0 victory Saturday. South Carolina netminder Mark Dekanich stopped 21 shots to earn the shutout, and South Carolina held the Thunder to 0-for-5 on the power play.

POWER PLAY GOALS HARD TO COME BY

The Stingrays and Thunder enter this evening's game as two of the league's top teams in the ECHL on the penalty kill in the postseason. Adirondack ranks second at 91.2% (34 times shorthanded, three goals allowed) while South Carolina is third at 87.1% (31 times shorthanded, four goals allowed). Both teams are 1-for-11 in the series on the power play. The Stingrays finished the regular season with the ECHL's best penalty kill at 87.5%.

SHOOTING GALLERY

In the postseason, the Stingrays have outshot their opponents in all seven games. South Carolina is firing the second most shots per game in the postseason at 35.14, while allowing the least shots at 22.43. Meanwhile, Adirondack has only outshot their opponent once in the playoffs and has only taken 37 shots versus the Stingrays in the series so far. They are second to last in the postseason with only 24.29 shots for per game.

TAKE THE LEAD, WIN THE GAME

In the postseason, both South Carolina and Adirondack are unbeaten when leading after the second period of play. Both teams are 5-0 when they hold a lead through 40 minutes of play.

South Carolina goaltender Mark Dekanich has two assists in five postseason appearances.

2015-16 IN-REVIEW

The 2015-2016 regular season was one to remember for the South Carolina Stingrays. The club finished with a record of 44-18-7-3, good for 2nd in the ECHL's Eastern Conference. The Stingrays won the South Division Championship, finishing with 98 points. That mark is the second highest point total in team history, trailing just the 1996-97 club, which finished with 100 points in 70 games.

Coming off a season in which the Stingrays fell in Game 7 of the Kelly Cup Finals to the Allen Americans, expectations were high for the team. In total, seven players who were members of the Stingrays 2016 Kelly Cup Playoffs roster appeared in games this season for South Carolina, including alternate captains Patrick Gaul and Joe Devin. Andrew Rowe was once again named team captain after returning from the AHL, but only skated in 28 games for the team due to recalls to the AHL and a long-term injury.

Despite the loss of star goaltender and ECHL MVP Jeff Jakaitis, South Carolina had a record-setting season in net. Netminders Mark Dekanich and Vitek Vanecek combined to allow only 162 goals, a club record. Dekanich finished second in the ECHL with a .925 save-percentage and claimed 20 wins while Vanecek, a second round pick of the Washington Capitals, was a member of the All-Rookie Team and finished second in the league with a 2.03 goals-against average.

Stephan Vigier, who returned for his second stint in South Carolina in an early season trade with Toledo, finished the season as the team leader with 24 goals. David Pacan was the team's leading scorer with a career-best 62 points (20 goals, 42 assists). On the blue line, the defense pairing of Joey Leach and Bobby Shea finished a combined +69, with Leach posting a league-best +40 mark.

While it was not a 23-game winning streak like the club had during the 2014-15 season, the 2015-16 Stingrays once again played their best hockey in the second half of the season. The Stingrays went 26-8-5-2 in the 2016 portion of the season, including finishing the year with a 16-game unbeaten in regulation streak. South Carolina went 12-0-3-1 to end the season. The club finished with the league's best penalty kill (87.5%) and the fourth best power play (19.6%).
